Fellowship Committee Job Description

The purpose of the Fellowship Committee of Messiah Lutheran Church is to create a spiritual communion within the church and to develop friendly relationships among current and prospective members.

A. Organization:

The Fellowship Committee shall consist of a chairperson, council liaison, and volunteer members of the congregation as needed. The committee shall meet as necessary to fulfill the statement of purpose. The chairperson of the Fellowship Committee may appoint a volunteer member(s) to organize and direct fellowship events.

B. Responsibilities:

- 1. To sponsor the following major events:
 - a. Yard Sale**
 - b. Congregational Picnic/Sunday School Opening.**
 - c. Grand Chili Cook off/Halloween Party**
 - d. New Member Fellowship**
 - e. Father/Son Event**
 - f. Mother/Daughter Event****
- 2. To sponsor additional fellowship events as needed.**
- 3. To annually evaluate the work of the committee and evaluate the committee job description, making necessary changes as required.**
- 4. To provide budget needs and event spending to the Finance Committee and monitor those needs and spending throughout the church year.**
- 5. To provide an annual report to the congregation at the May annual meeting.**

C. Relationships

The Fellowship Committee reports to and is accountable to the church council. The committee also works with and maintains a liaison with all other standing committees in the church.
