

Lord Use Me
The Story of St. Francis

Then I heard the voice of the Lord saying, "Whom shall I send, and who will go for us?" And I said, "Here am I, send me!" --Isaiah 6:8

Dear Friends of the living Messiah,

"LORD, USE ME," is a concise prayer. A friend taught me that prayer and I stole the words to entitle a children's musical based on the life of St. Francis of Assisi. (The children of MLC will present this musical during worship at both services on Sunday, June 13. Don't miss it!) "Lord, use me," is more than a title: It is our mission as people of God.

"GOD DOES IT ALL," we Lutherans are anxious to remind ourselves and share with anyone who will listen. And, it is true: God claims and names us in Baptism. God keeps speaking His word to us. God cares for us through the people of His Church. And, Lord feeds us with His very self in the Lord's Supper. Heaven, our eternal destination, is clearly promised by our Lord. So what is left for us to do? Is there some way to shout, "Thank you," to God? When we ask that question, we are beginning to talk about mission.

GOD CAN AND WILL USE US. In June Messiah Lutheran will have three missionaries to Guatemala—Christina Daniel, Dennis Fry, and Bill Emerson, and five missionaries to the NW Territories of Canada—Heather and Debbie Neely, Sue Doubleday, Lois Graff, and Songae Wasmoen. They are the ambassadors of MLC to our Christian sisters and brothers to the south and the north. (Like astronauts, they are the ones that go, but that could not happen without all of us back here 'on the ground'.) Yet...

**"LORD, USE ME,"** is **our** prayer wherever we are. You and I have callings too. How is God going to use us? Here is where the prayer of St. Francis might give us direction and inspiration.

Lord, make us instruments of your peace.

Where there is hatred, let us sow love; where there is injury, pardon; Where there is doubt, faith; where there is despair, hope; Where there is darkness, light; where there is sadness, joy. Grant that we may not so much seek to be consoled as to console; to be understood as to understand; to be loved as to love. For it is in giving that we receive; it is in pardoning that we are pardoned; and it is in dying that we are born to eternal life.

May God use you and me in the coming days. And may we keep returning to our Lord for renewal and then go out again with renewed energy and joy.

#### **Incarnation Information June 2010**

"These people who have been turning the world upside down have come here also." Acts 17:6

The book of Acts begins with a small group of seemingly insignificant people, but by Acts 17 the officials in Thessalonica are saying these followers of Jesus are "people who have been turning the world upside down." So what happened that caused this small, insignificant group to be able to turn the world upside down? What can we learn by studying the book of Acts? After all, Acts is the story of the original mission congregation. What can our small, insignificant group at Incarnation learn from the book of Acts to start turning the Harvest-Monrovia community upside down? That is going to be our focus this summer.

Starting June 13 (when Pastor Mark is back from Vacation and Synod Assembly) we will begin a journey through Acts that will define both the message and the format of worship each week. It will also be the focus of weekly Wednesday night fellowship, prayer and Bible study. We want to learn more than just methods; we want to experience the same intimacy with God and boldness in sharing the good news that defined the people in Acts. We want to be intentional to pray for the sick, to depend on the power of the Holy Spirit and to boldly proclaim the cross and resurrection of Jesus. Through all of this we hope to keep the conversation of what we are learning and discussing alive by inviting as many people as possible to join our Facebook discussion at Incarnation Lutheran Church - Harvest, AL.

Work is going well on the Thrivent **Habitat for Humanity** house. A number of our members are involved in the building on Saturdays. New volunteers are always welcome.

The church rummage sale and bake sale at Messiah was held on May 22, to support the Habitat project. Thank you to all who contributed clothes, household items, and baked goods for the rummage sale. Special thanks to Paulette McNamara for heading up the sale and to all who assisted in running the sale. Over \$1,900 was raised for Habitat.

Messiah has an ongoing supportive relationship with the **Milestone Children's Corner** in Huntsville. Over \$2,900 was donated from the Lenten offerings to be used for a new and safer fence around the play area. Milestone has done a number of fundraisers to add to our donation to cover the cost of the fence. The new fence will be installed on May 24. Thank you. The box for new or gently used toys, games, and books remains in the narthex at Messiah and donations are always welcome. Thank you to those who have continued to bring in donations. They are very much appreciated. On a recent visit to Milestone I saw toys and CD players donated by Messiah members being used in the daycare rooms. Milestone continues to grow and is a very exciting outreach in the community.

Community outreach funds were used to provide diapers for those affected by the recent tornadoes in Alabama. Supplies were being collected at Grace Lutheran Church.
