Fellowship Committee Job Description

The purpose of the Fellowship Committee of Messiah Lutheran Church is to create a spiritual communion within the church and to develop friendly relationships among current and prospective members.

A. Organization:

The Fellowship Committee shall consist of a chairperson, council liaison, and volunteer members of the congregation as needed. The committee shall meet as necessary to fulfill the statement of purpose. The chairperson of the Fellowship Committee may appoint a volunteer member(s) to organize and direct fellowship events.

B. Responsibilities:

- 1. To sponsor the following major events:
 - a. Yard Sale
 - b. Congregational Picnic/Sunday School Opening.
 - c. Grand Chili Cook off/Halloween Party
 - d. New Member Fellowship
 - e. Father/Son Event
 - f. Mother/Daughter Event
- 2. To sponsor additional fellowship events as needed.
- 3. To annually evaluate the work of the committee and evaluate the committee job description, making necessary changes as required.
- 4. To provide budget needs and event spending to the Finance Committee and monitor those needs and spending throughout the church year.
- 5. To provide an annual report to the congregation at the May annual meeting.

C. Relationships

The Fellowship Committee reports to and is accountable to the church council. The committee also works with and maintains a liaison with all other standing committees in the church.
