WE ARE ONE HALF IN LENT, ONE HALF IN EASTER this month. April 1-15 is Lent. April 16-30 is Easter. Good Friday is April 14, and Easter Sunday is April 16, so it is not too late to give things up for Lent, and it is hard not to anticipate the joy of Easter.

9 Things that Everybody Should "Give Up" for Lent by Pastor Mark Anderson, Corona del Mar, CA.

1) **COMPLAINING** – there is much to be thankful for.

2) WORRY – there are things to be concerned about, but nothing to worry about.

3) DISCOURAGEMENT – God is for you, not against you.

4) BITTERNESS – it's like poisoning yourself. How smart is that?

5) HATRED – forgive and watch your future come alive!

6) GOSSIPING – speak well of your neighbor; you might see him/her return the favor.

7) BLAMING – be part of the solution, not the problem.

8) STAYING AWAY FROM CHURCH – provide your family with a firm foundation of faith, learn about the message of God's love from the Bible, share problems, make friends, and be renewed in hope, and thank God for another week of life. And it's free!

9) GIVING UP - hang in there! Despite all life's problems it is a good and gracious gift!

t's sometimes difficult to sit still for an hour in church especially if you're between four and nine years old!

Around five years ago, Messiah Lutheran started offering *Children's Church* for fidgety young disciples. At first, the program took place during the 11:00 service of worship only and had just a few participants, but it has grown to include 6-12 children at both services of worship on any given Sunday. their kiddos receive at Children's Church and often come back to visit again.

What happens when the children leave the service of worship just before the sermon? They meet in the Fellowship Hall for a brief lesson—and, of course, a snack and drink! The current curriculum comes from *The Big Book of Kid Sermons and Object Talks: 52 Instant Lessons That Children Will Remember* (Big Books) and features fun, insightful, interactive activities that introduce the Bible to our church's younger learners. The best part is that the Children's Church Coordinator, Mary Mast, organizes the materials for each week into handy kits—volunteers don't have to prepare lessons!

Children's Church needs your help! There is an urgent need for regular and substitute volunteers to teach these short classes during the sermon at the 8:30 and/or 11:00 services. There are 8-10 slots available each month. You don't have to have a child who attends Children's Church – most volunteers don't! If enough volunteers staff the regular rotation, no one teaches more than one or two times a month with a partner. This is a great opportunity for youth volunteers to help out!
