NEWS! WILLIAM STRAND ORDINATION IN THE FUTURE? On April 21, William Strand, son of Stephen and Claire, was approved by the SE Synod Candidacy Committee as a Candidate preparing for Ordination into the Ministry of Word and Sacrament.

WERE YOU ORDAINED? If you were Baptized, **yes!**, you were ordained into Christian ministry. When we were Baptized by our Lord it was for a purpose. The Spirit of the risen Jesus intends to use us in God's service. The highest office Jesus bestows is 'Disciple'.

NEWS! THE ORDINATION OF EMMA JAMES GIPNER is planned for May 20 at the 11:00 a.m. service of worship. The infant daughter of Kristin and Andrew will be named and claimed by her Heavenly Father in Baptism and ordained as a disciple of Jesus. Her Lord has plans for Emma.

MORE NEWS! EIGHT DISCIPLES PREPARING TO AFFIRM BAPTISM. On their Baptism days these disciples' parents, sponsors, and the assembled congregation confessed our Christian faith using the words of the Apostles' Creed. On May 20, these disciples will speak for themselves. In their affirmation vows they will be asked,

DO YOU INTEND to continue in the promises God made to you in Holy Baptism:

- +to live among God's faithful people,
- +to hear his Word and share in his supper,
- +to proclaim the good news of God in Christ through word and deed,
- +to serve all people, following the example of our Lord Jesus,
- +and to strive for justice and peace in all the earth? (LBW p. 201)

THOSE ARE GOOD VOWS FOR ALL WHO ARE CALLED TO BE DISCIPLES. On May 20 we will celebrate the Baptism of Emma, we will celebrate the Affirmation of Baptism for those eight disciples who have been preparing for their Confirmation day, and we will celebrate Pentecost Day. On Pentecost, 50 days after the resurrection of Jesus, the Holy Spirit descended upon Jesus' first disciples. After disciple Peter preached a sermon, the Holy Spirit was very busy as about 3,000 new disciples were Baptized.

THE SPIRIT OF THE RISEN JESUS IS STILL AT WORK AMONG US! Let's celebrate the new disciples being raised up among us and joyfully serve our Lord in our daily callings.

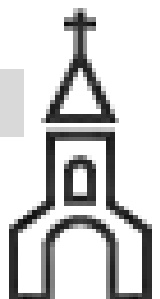

MINISTRY SPOTLIGHT: MEN'S & WOMEN'S FELLOWSHIP GROUPS

Men of Messiah - It is somewhat ironic that Messiah's men's fellowship group calls themselves the MoMs but so it is. The group is led by good-humored friends and fellow church members Mark Zesinger and Pete Woods. It started a few years back when the pair would occasionally meet up for a post-work beer at one of Madison's new local breweries, and share the joys and concerns of family, work, and church life. They decided that other MLC men might enjoy such Christian fellowship, and that led to the first MoMs meeting on April 28, 2016 at Old Black Bear brewpub in downtown Madison.

The very informal group of a dozen (or so) men meet on the 4th Tuesday of the month at 5:30 p.m. The meetings are casual and newcomers and friends are encouraged! Locations vary and are announced a few weeks prior via e-mail and MLC E-News. The group occasionally will meet at member's homes. There's no need to RSVP; just show up and stay as long or short as you have time and Christian fellowship to share. Mark and Pete welcome suggestions for new places to meet, or new activities, service projects, or events to do. (Top Golf, a Men's Retreat, Fishing, Bowling, etc.) Contact Mark or Pete if interested.

Messiah's Women's Book & Social Club - In the fall of 2012, Janell Zesinger started a bi-monthly Mom's Bible Study on Monday mornings. As schedules, availability, and membership evolved, the group became what it is today, a monthly Women's Book and Social Club. The group reads four to six books about the Christian faith annually. The group meets at member's homes at 7 p.m. on the 2nd Monday, August through May. As their name implies, the group is also social! The August, December, and May meetings are "social only" months where members get together for fellowship - no reading required! Vulpius did not have the resources to attend university, however he taught Latin and served as a Lutheran cantor and teacher in Weimar until his death. He was a prolific composer, writing nearly 200 motets, 400 hymn tunes, and a St. Matthew Passion.

Question: Messiah’s Emblem

We know what it is, but *what does it mean?*

Answer. Messiah’s triquetra-shaped emblem, right, springs from the Biblical meaning of *Messiah: the Anointed One*. Symbols radiating from the central cross of the crucified Messiah are the crown of Old Testament Kings who were *anointed* when coronated, the shell of Baptism reminds us that Jesus was *anointed* in Baptism to begin His ministry, the flame recalls when disciples were *anointed* with the Holy Spirit on Pentecost Day. The three arms symbolize the Trinity: God the Father our King, Jesus our Savior, and the Holy Spirit who enlivens us in faith.



History: Messiah’s emblem was developed by Pastor Scott in the first weeks of MLC’s development. An early version of it appears on MLC’s Membership Charter. A description of its design is in MLC’s first Constitution & Bylaws. In 2012 Meredith Kilby updated the emblem and made it available in a wide variety of formats for both print and web.
