Dear Friends of the Living Messiah,

"WHAT DID YOU DO DURING THE PANDEMIC OF 2020?" children will ask. What will those stories be? We might complain, "There were so many things we could

not do. We were isolated and bombarded with bad news. It was miserable." OR we might be anxious to tell a child, "It was an amazing time! That virus clearly showed us what was 'essential and vital' vs. 'not so important.' When we were forced to pause, we realized how precious friends and community are in life. Once again, God used a tragic time to make people creative in caring for each other."

FAITHFUL JEWS SEEM TO AGREE: "The best time in our history was out in the wilderness. That's when the Lord used Moses to lead us out of slavery in Egypt and into freedom in the Promised Land." What made those "the best of times" for Israel? As Israel wandered in the wilderness, the Lord provided "daily bread." The Lord led them to new life as a nation. They had no choice but to rely on the Lord. Their time in the wilderness was not easy, but the wilderness was where they learned to trust the Lord for nourishment and new life.

MLC ORGANIZED AS A CONGREGATION 30 YEARS AGO ON MAY 20, 1990. Some of us have stories to tell about those days. Some would say, "Those were the 'good old days"! All we had to hang on to were faith in our Lord and each other, so we did. We had no building, no traditions, no easy comforts, yet together we learned that the Lord provides all we need for life and a future." On the other hand, some might say, "Oh! It was a miserable time: No building, few church programs, a shabby meeting place—it was like fighting for survival in the wilderness."

MLC CELEBRATED AND USED THE GIFTS GOD PROVIDED rather than whine about what we lacked. Since those early days, we have learned from experience: The more we invest in missions, the more our Lord provides for us to grow in missions. God's divine accounting practices and generosity are blessings to us which lead to ongoing miracle.s

SOME PEOPLE SAY, "JESUS WAS POOR." JESUS NEVER SAID THAT. He came on a mission, totally giving Himself away so that we might be filled to overflowing with blessings and life. **What is our story these days?** "This we lack" OR "God provides?"

JESUS SAID, "Forgive, and you will be forgiven; give, and it will be given to you. A good measure, pressed down, shaken together, running over, will be put into your lap; for the measure you give will be the measure you get back." --Luke 6:37-38

A Few Words on Liturgy... The Prayer of the Church

The Prayer of the Church generally follows the offertory. The placement here encompasses three parts: offering of gifts, offertory response, and prayers (offering of intercessions to Christ, "the high priest," as Clement of Rome called Him). The prayer, with petitions, is composed to highlight the scripture text(s) and season of the church year. The petitions are timely, congregational, and universal in scope, revealing the mind of the Church. Petition responses involve the congregation liturgically.

Hymn of the Month

"O Master, Let Me Walk with You"

Washington Gladden (1836-1918), a Congregational minister, wrote the text for this hymn in 1879. According to *hymnary.org*, "Throughout his ministry he emphasized applying the gospel to life in America." The tune "MARYTON" may be the only one that Anglican priest Henry Percy Smith (1825-1898) ever composed. During these days we are called to serve while still finding our paths. As we do, we learn more about patience, which makes this verse especially speak to us today:

Teach me your patience; share with me

A closer, dearer company,

In work that keeps faith sweet and strong,

In trust that triumphs over wrong.


