Dear Friends of the living Messiah,

WE FOCUS ON THE VERY HEART OF OUR CHRISTIAN FAITH IN LENT. Love is the way with our Lord. The love of God which arrived in the person of Jesus was costly beyond our imaginations. Jesus literally was *"The body of Christ broken for you, and the blood of Christ shed for you."* Nothing was held back in God's reconciling work to repair the broken relationship between God and humanity.

THE ENTIRE MONTH OF MARCH IS IN LENT. On March 15, 2020, we had our last regular Sunday morning indoor services of worship. Now, one year later, here are some things bouncing around in my head:

MISSION OPPORTUNITIES ARE OVERFLOWING! We have thousands of new neighbors in our area. Most of them arrived not looking for a church home. As *"God's People, Reaching Out,"* we are called to reach out to them where they live and work. More of our mission outreach will need to adapt to finding common hopes and fears with people who see no value in our Lord's Church. The Holy Spirit will use us to work creatively, patiently, and persistently to show the abundant life found in our Lord.

I PRAY THE NEW SIGN IS AN EFFECTIVE OUTREACH TOOL. I hope it will be up and functioning before the end of this month. Our significant investments of time and finances were not driven to meet our own needs but in hopes of engaging the unchurched.

Three new ideas for messages on the sign:

+WANT A GUIDE FOR LIFE? I AM AVAILABLE. –God

+I LOVE IT WHEN YOU TALK TO ME. I ALWAYS LISTEN. –God

+TRAVEL THROUGH LIFE WITH TRUST. I AM WITH YOU. —God

The interest-free loan from an MLC household approved at the November Congregation Meeting to complete the sign has been made for \$14K.

VACCINES! Some in our community have received both doses of the COVID-19 vaccine. On February 18, I received my first dose. I hope to safely do home Communion visits to the homebound by Holy Week. Let's pray that before the end of summer, indoor worship and Faith Formation classes will regularly meet in person inside the MLC building. (Remember: The church is the people of God gathered around God's Word and the Sacraments of Baptism and the Lord's Supper. The church is not a building. But, our building is a great tool for the mission of our Lord's church.)

ONLINE WORSHIP IS HERE TO STAY! Even when we are free to meet indoors for Sunday worship, preparations are being made to enable people to join us in worship each Sunday via the MLC website www.mlutheran.org.

May God bless you in this season of Lent as we prepare to celebrate Easter,

Outreach Spotlight: Davidson Farms Cottage Community

Davidson Farms Cottage Community

Unless otherwise designated, our midweek Lenten offerings will benefit the construction of a cottage community on the *Davidson Farms* property in Toney, Alabama. *Davidson Farms* is a foster home for girls ages 10 - 19. It is one of several initiatives of the **Kids to Love** organization that serves the needs of youth in our area's foster care system.

Often, foster children who age out of foster care need more time to learn how to live independently. The construction of 5 tiny homes, called the *Cottage Community*, will provide safe housing for young women as they learn the skills they need to live on their own while pursuing a career or continuing their education.

A ground breaking ceremony was held last September. Julie Reyburn, the *Kids to Love* Communications Director, reports that recently the county approved the site plans.

Hymn of the Month - "O Christ, Your Heart, Compassionate"

The German tune "Ellacombe" was published in *Gesangbuch der Herzogl* (1784) and was slightly altered in later hymnals. Rev. Dr. Herman Stuempfle, Jr. (1923-2007) wrote the text of this hymn. Stuempfle served as President of the Lutheran Theological Seminary in Gettysburg and was a prolific author of books, articles, and lectures. The love of God and Stuempfle's heart for social ministry is especially noticeable in this hymn.

*O Christ, your heart, compassionate, bore ev'ry human pain.
Its beating was the pulse of God; its breadth, God's vast domain.
The heart of God, the heart of Christ combined in perfect rhyme
To write God's love in human deeds, eternity in time.*

*O Love that made the distant stars, yet marks the sparrow's fall,
Whose arms stretched wide upon a cross embrace and bear us all:
Come, make your church a servant church that walks your servant ways,
Whose deeds of love rise up to you, a sacrifice of praise! (ELW #722 vs 1,4)*

Restroom Facelift Project Update

As I write this article for the March Newsletter, I can see the light at the end of the tunnel after working several months on the restroom facelift project. Since COVID-19 happened, it was a good time to get this project completed while the church was closed down. On behalf of the Appearance Committee, I wrote a proposal for the church council that was presented in November. It got approved, and work moved forward as volunteers had time to give of their talents.

The restrooms now have a new look and are ready for when the church building re-opens for members and guests. All seven restrooms have a new floor and new paint on the walls. All the stall dividers and ten toilets had to be removed and then reinstalled once the new floor and paint jobs got completed. The Fellowship Hall kitchen also received a new floor and new quarter round. The main ladies restroom across from the library got extra attention with a new ADA double sink vanity, framed mirror, corner shelving, and a light fixture above the vanity.

Please thank the following church members who gave of their energy, time, and talents to get this project completed: Richard Webb, Lee Smith, Peter Woods, Rick Baggett, Bob Gustafson, Audrey Gustafson, Linda Ruhl, Aaron Woods, Mark Zesinger, James Zesinger, Merritt Zesinger, Mark Thompson, and Beth Thompson. I certainly appreciate their willingness to work and the donation of their skills to this endeavor. I also want to thank the MLC staff for putting up with the mess and inconvenience during these weeks. Thanks also to Property for replacing the old fluorescent bulbs with new LED bulbs in the restrooms.

You might be wondering where the funding for this project came from, as it was not a budget item. Funds came from three sources: 1) MLC Facility Appearance Account, which members donate to so improvements may be made to our church; 2) Tim and Kay Spence's donation for the new double sink vanity, which the Appearance Committee picked out; and 3) Thrivent Choice Account, through which Thrivent members may designate their Choice Dollars. As a reminder, Thrivent members have until March 31st to designate their 2020 Choice Dollars.

The only labor cost was for the new floors, which ended up being a two-day job, as their team also removed the old tile. All other work was done by MLC volunteers.
