Dear Friends of the restless Messiah,

October 1988: As a Yankee who had just moved into Madison from SW Minnesota, I looked around and was struck by a thought: "Look around you. What a fertile mission field! God must have plans for a great harvest in this place! It even includes an

area named Harvest." The Holy Spirit began an adventure which fulfilled my dreams and the dreams of others who hoped to be missionaries. Nineteen months later when we organized as a congregation on May 20, 1990, over 60% of the 159 charter members did not have a church home prior to joining MLC. In March 1994, when MLC completed building a mission outpost, we put pews instead of moveable chairs in the worship space. We designed the altar and pulpit using heavy oak to prevent them from being easily moved. Why? To communicate **stability** as we gathered to worship surrounded by a rapidly **changing** mission field. We wanted Sunday morning worship to be in a sanctuary in the midst of a turbulent world.

"I tell you, look around you, and see how the fields are ripe for harvesting," Jesus said to His first disciples. Jesus' words spoke to us as MLC developed and grew along with this area. In Fall 1988, Madison was on the verge of surpassing 10,000 residents. Recently Madison grew beyond 50,000. Madison County is surging toward 400K. Limestone County has gone over 100K.

<u>May 2021</u>: "I tell you, look around you, and see how the fields are ripe for harvesting." A new generation sprung up and is passing by us on life's highway. The speed of change is frightening. No wonder God's messenger angels announced great changes on the horizon beginning with the words "Do not be afraid." This is the Lord who still sends Biblical text messages and speaks messages calling us into mission. This is the Lord who came to earth in the person of Jesus to speak God's Word face-to-face with disciples. This is the Lord who called missionary Paul to make disciples for Jesus among Gentiles like us. This is the same Lord who calls us now in 2021.

In the midst of this ever-changing world, God gives stability. God bestows peace in our identity as children of God. Our Lord's unwavering love for us and all God's people is reason to give thanks and praise. Our Lord's call to make disciples gives us missionary work on this great mission field which is ripe for harvest.

As we emerge from the COVID-19 pandemic, let's keep looking for more opportunities to serve together. We are people of the Word God has given us to share. That Word is the Good News of our Lord and Savior Jesus the Messiah.



Music Camp

Little did we know what was ahead when writing the new musical *The Forever Adventure* in early 2020. This was not supposed to be "forever" as in "let's wait 2 years!" However, in early January 2021, when preparations would begin in earnest for a summer Music Camp, COVID-19 vaccines had just started being administered, and it was unclear how safe it would be to have MLC's Music Camp in June.

From Deacon John E. Weit, ELCA's Executive for Worship on April 19, 2021:

"One metric suggests a threshold of 70% to 85% of the nation's population being fully vaccinated as a goal for safe singing in person in larger groups. This means robust singing will likely be one of the last things to fully resume. We continue to trust scientists and medical professionals as they help us to make informed decisions on important worship practices."

For the safety of children, leaders, and the community, the premiere of *The Forever Adventure* will need to wait until June 6-12, 2022.

Hymn of the Month: "Here in This Place"

Marty Haugen (b. 1950), the composer of *Holden Evening Prayer*, wrote the text and tune of this popular hymn. As some members and guests transition back to worshiping in MLC's sanctuary, the hymn reminds us that we are gathered together in whatever spaces God has given us.
