When I arrived here in Madison, I was struck by how brown everyone's lawns were. I was told that the grass is dormant right now and the lawns would be a lush green again when the weather starts warming up.

The grass back home was green all year unless you really did something majorly wrong. Our grass would go dormant in the winter, but it always stayed green. Being dormant simply meant no need to mow.

Springtime is one of my favorite times of the year. It is a time when you can almost physically see things coming to life. All the vegetation that seemed to be stagnant over the past few months is poking its head out, and yes, the grass is turning green.

Without YOUR input, the Transition Team will not be able to get a well rounded perspective on where God is calling Messiah and the type of leader that will stretch and challenge Messiah to continue to grow and spread the Gospel.

It is springtime, a time to be giddy and dream about the days to come. Open yourselves up to God's dream for Messiah. Allow yourselves to engage in dreams that you have never dreamt before. Don't fear them or turn from them simply because they are new and possibly scary. It is the beginning of a whole new season.

Outreach Spotlight: Owen's House for Women and Children

Kitchen Servers Sought for Owen's House Mission

Well before COVID-19, a local Messiah Lutheran Church mission was to support the women and children at Owen's House, which is part of Huntsville's Downtown Rescue Mission.

MLC's two-part approach was to provide financial support so that healthy food was always available to those who ate at Owen's House but also to serve supper twice a month to residents.

The pandemic halted the food serving part of MLC's mission outreach, but now that COVID risks are reduced, we plan to restart this. **Come be a part! We will work on the supper service line the first Monday of each month beginning in April starting at 4:45 p.m.** If you are interested in this mission work, please contact Claire Strand or Bill Emerson. A short training session will be provided for those who have not previously worked at Owen's House.

Owen's House provides temporary overnight shelter plus supper and breakfast for homeless women and their children. Owen's House also provides a multi-month program that teaches women in need of life skills and helps them find jobs.

What’s the Transition Team up to?

The Transition Team had their first meeting on March 17th to discuss their responsibilities.

The purpose of the Transition Team is to complete MLC’s Ministry Site Profile (MSP). The MSP is an ELCA form that collects a wide range of information about a church— its people, location, ministries, facilities, finances, etc. It’s essentially MLC’s “resume.”

When the Transition Team finishes its work on the MSP, it is presented to the congregation for review. The MSP then makes its way to the Call Committee for final review (one member of the Transition Team will also serve on the Call Committee). The final MSP is submitted to Bishop Kevin Strickland of the ELCA’s Southeastern Synod, who will use its data to find the pastor candidates best suited for MLC.

Over the next several months, the Transition Team will need **YOUR** help compiling the data required to complete the MSP. At their meeting, the team discussed ideas like surveys, small “cottage meetings”, and a big collaborative timeline as possible ways to collect info.

The Transition Team is dedicated to being transparent. There are no hidden agendas. The team will provide frequent updates using methods like Temple Talks, meetings, E-News, the newsletter, and the website. Above all, the team’s job is *not to* push its own agendas but to *listen*.

Pastor Diana has emphasized that every voice at MLC must be heard, and the Transition Team wholeheartedly agrees. Therefore, the team will use a variety of methods to collect data, including in-person, Internet, telephone, and mail. That way, all congregation members, even if they are ill, traveling, busy, homebound, or shy, can share their opinions.

The Transition Team thanks all of you for your cooperation and prayers!
