Affirm (June 11-16): We have several students signed up to attend Affirm this summer, which is being held at the University of West Alabama in Livingston, AL. Affirm is a summer youth event of the ELCA Southeastern Synod which is designed to nurture faith, equip youth leaders for today and tomorrow, and train youth in discipleship skills. Please pray for these young disciples as they travel to this camp in mid June.

ELCA National Youth Gathering (July 16-20, 2024): Mark your calendars for the 2024 National Youth Gathering in New Orleans, which is open to all youth who will be entering grades 8-12 by the fall of 2023! We need to register this fall (from Sept. 15 to Nov. 1, 2023) to receive the priority rate of \$375 per person. After that, the price increases. There will be additional costs for hotel, transportation, and meals, so the youth will be planning several fundraisers to help cover all of the costs. Watch for ways that you can help our youth participate in this event!

NEW! ELCA National Young Adult Gathering (July 16-20, 2024): During the same time period, the ELCA is also offering a new Young Adult Gathering for individuals aged 18-35. The young adults will have separate activities from the youth but will join with them for the Mass Gathering. For the Young Adult Gathering, the priority registration cost (Sept. 15 to Nov. 1, 2023) is \$260 (plus hotel, transportation, and meals). We are exploring possible ways to provide some assistance to Messiah young adults and alumni who may be interested in attending. Watch for further details.
