Outreach Spotlight: Kentucky Disaster Recovery Mission Trip By Andrew King, Council Outreach Representative

MLC Helping Long Term After Disaster Strikes!

For this year's annual mission trip, we'll be returning to Kentucky to support long term disaster recovery efforts from the 2021 tornadoes that impacted the western part of the state. Thousands of homes were damaged or destroyed in the storm, mainly in low income areas and disproportionately impacting renters. The response effort is currently active in three counties: Graves (where Mayfield is located), Marshall, and Hopkins.

How can you help?

- Volunteer with our mission team! Dates are June 21 June 25. Volunteers must be 16 years of age or older, and youth under 18 must be accompanied by their parent or legal guardian. Parsonage Sale Details

On Friday, April 14, 2023, Messiah Lutheran Church sold its church parsonage at 600 Highland Drive to a couple with young children relocating to the area from Connecticut. Congregation Council members present at closing were Gregory Kilby (Vice-President), Lee Smith (Financial Rep), and Lisa Evers (Property Rep).

The process of selling went very smoothly! The parsonage was listed at \$419,000 on March 13, 2023 with Matt Curtis Real Estate. The first day of the listing, two offers were received. The Parsonage Subcommittee recommended acceptance of a \$429,000 purchase offer with closing in one month.

Once under contract, the home was appraised and inspected and essential repairs requested by the buyers were completed at MLC's expense. Repairs to the home included repairs to the foundation, plumbing, HVAC, and handyman carpentry repairs to seven windows.

As a requirement for closing, MLC held a Special Congregation Meeting on Tuesday, April 11 at 7 p.m., and unanimously approved a resolution approving the sale of the property under the terms listed in the Purchase Contract and to meet Alabama statutes for churches selling corporately owned property.

After repairs, closing costs, real estate commissions, etc.* MLC expects to clear approximately \$395,000 from the sale.

*At the May 7 Congregation Meeting the Council will make a motion to conduct the parsonage sale outside of the 2023 Plan for Mission/Budget; such that preparation costs, repairs, and closing costs are subtracted from the buyer's purchase price and outside of the MLC's 2023 Plan for Mission/Budget; further, the net proceeds will be placed into a designated parsonage proceeds account until the Congregation determines the disposition of the proceeds.
