# April 28, 2024 Town Hall: Preview of May 5 Meeting with Elections, Financial Update, and Roundtable Discussions on Parsonage Proceeds

On April 18 a town-hall style meeting was held to preview the agenda for the May 5 Congregation Meeting. Council President Neda Ballard reviewed the agenda and slate of nominees up for election to the 2024-25 Council and Nominating Committee. The list of nominated members with their brief biographies can be found on www.mlutheran.org/documents page (a password is

required to access). Also on the agenda is the 2023-2024 Church Council Annual Report. It is also on the mlutheran.org/documents page. This document, though quite lengthy, serves as a historical record of the life of the church this past year -- it captures MLC's membership statistics and attendance records, includes a report by Pastor Kris, and summarizes the key decisions and work done by your elected church leadership.

The meeting continued with MLC's Finance Committee members Lee Smith and Tim Pitchko. Lee highlighted attendance and year-to-date actuals. Tim presented slides with charts that will be used to model the primary components of Messiah's financial well-being as the year progresses.

The meeting finished with Laura Peterson leading a group round table discussion on the use of the parsonage sale proceeds. The proceeds of the parsonage sale are secured and bearing interest in two CD accounts. The proceeds will remain secured until the congregation decides how to utilize them. The questions which were presented and discussed in small breakout groups are available on the documents page. Expect additional roundtable discussions to come. Your input is important to these decisions.
