A Few Tips for Greeting Someone Unfamiliar to You @ MLC

Greet and welcome any unfamiliar faces you see at worship this summer. Summer is a time when there are new families in the area looking for new communities of faith.

- 1. Introduce yourself! Share something about yourself that ties to your church involvement or ministry participation outside of worship.
- 2. Be positive and helpful. Share what you love/enjoy about MLC, and encourage visitors to sign the guest book or fill out Connection Card before they leave.
- 3. Be observant. Are there cues in their outfit that could be a conversation starter (such as an alumni polo shirt, clothing accessory, handmade scarf, etc.)?
- 4. Talk about the weather! Commenting on the weather may seem cliche, but there is a reason this sort of icebreaker works. It's a simple, easy way to get a conversation rolling, offering a bit of common ground between two strangers.
- 5. Invite people to stay for fellowship coffee after the service, especially if you meet someone during the Passing of the Peace.
