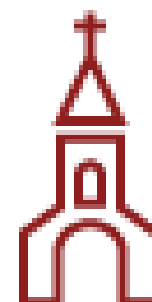

All About MLC's Columbarium

Columbarium Update: ever wonder about the wall of burial niches near the front of the sanctuary? As our columbarium, it is a place where people's cremated remains are interred.

The purpose of our columbarium is to maintain a member's or member family's remains in a perpetual and religious setting. You may have noticed there are some single and some double niches. These are assigned to individuals or couples respectively. As for the brass plates on some of the niches:

- Plates with names and dates are niches that contain deceased person's ashes.
- A blank plate indicates the niche has been reserved, but does not contain ashes at this time.
- No brass name plate indicates these niches are available to reserve/purchase for future use.

The cost of each niche is \$200.
