Kits and Quilts 2024 Recap - Nearly 2.5 Tons of Love

Congratulations to our Kit Ministry and Comforters groups for their efforts through this past year in making quilts and kits for Lutheran World Relief. On Sunday, August 25, over 150 boxes of kits and quilts were loaded on the LWR In-gathering trailer parked at MLC. Inside the boxes were 122 quilts, 696 personal care kits, 756 school kits, 416 baby kits, and 15 fabric kits totaling 4,946 pounds! That's just short of 2.5 tons of aide for Lutheran World Relief. Saint Marks contributed about 1000 pounds of aide in 26 boxes bringing the grand total to 5,906 pounds sent in 176 boxes! (Photo by Jack Mast)
